

Massachusetts Service Achievement Degree Application 20__ __

The PPAM Service Achievement Degree was established to honor members of PPAM who have contributed service and brought recognition to the Professional Photographers Association of Massachusetts.

The Service Achievement Degree is earned by accumulating 50 PPAM merit points as prescribed in the chart below. When all merits have been earned and the application approved, the PPAM medal on a green ribbon will be presented at the annual awards banquet during the convention. Members who have previously received the *Massachusetts Degree of Photographic Excellence* will be awarded the PPAM medal on a red ribbon to signify that they have received both degrees. When a member accumulates an additional 50 merits, above and beyond the first 50, he will receive a gold star to pin to the ribbon.

Merits must be applied for right after the year in which they occur. The one exception to this is if the member will be completing the 50 merits at the convention. The service must have been completed at that convention, such as being a speaker, judge, or print committee member.
